- Part of a series of events to support the ACT NOW! REACH 2013 campaign.
- Jointly organised by Cefic, Eurométaux, CONCAWE, Fecc and A.I.S.E with ECHA.
- Participants: manufacturers, downstream users, industry associations, NGOs, Member State competent & enforcement authorities and European Commission.
- Follow-on from ENES2 (21-22 May 2012, Helsinki)
- Areas identified for attention at ENES2:
 - SpERCs
 - Harmonisation of structure and content to aid communication
 - "Scaling" and the exposure scenario – clear understanding

ENES3: Two parts

 - Most substances end up in some form of mixture.
