# **Recent legislative work**

Regulation (EU) No 167/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 February 2013 on the approval and market surveillance of agricultural and forestry vehicles

- OJ Reference: OJ L 60,2.3.2013, p. 1
- Applicable from: **1 Jan 2016**

Directive 2012/24/EU on the update to technical progress of front PTO requirements, OJ L 274,9.10.2012, p.24

Directive 2013/8/EU on three new mechanical couplings compliant to international standard, OJ L 56,28.2.2013, p. 8



### Overview of the Regulation on approval and market surveillance of agricultural & forestry vehicles approval -1

Clear scope

 Exclusion of tractors from the Machinery Directive 2006/42/EC
 Inclusion of Utility All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs) and Utility Sideby-Side Vehicles (SbS) if they comply with the definitions set out in the regulation

Safety requirements Environmental performance Administrative requirements Access to RMI

*Type-Approval granting Market surveillance introduced by the co-legislators* 



### **Overview of the Regulation on approval and market surveillance of agricultural & forestry vehicles approval -2**

Repeal of main directive for Type-Approval and of "old" separate directives – replaced by delegated & implementing acts according to:

*♦ simplification* 

- ♦ better regulation
- coherence with other type-approval acts
- International standards
- ♦ Lisbon treaty



# **Current legislative work**

#### Four Delegated acts:

- environmental and propulsion performance (REPPR)
- functional safety aspects (RVFSR)
- construction requirements (RVCR)
- braking system requirements (RBSR)
  - \* emphasis on fast tractors + updated test requirements
  - \* on-going Impact Assessment

#### One Implementing act:

or administrative requirements (RAR)

# 1<sup>st</sup> draft by European Commission: June – July 2013

comment by Member States and Stakeholders: October – November 2013

adoption by European Commission:
 June – July 2014

 May 2013

 Working Groups for Member States and Stakeholders consultation: six up to end 2013
 \* two of them dedicated to Member States only
